Fr Phillip writes...

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

In our First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles this Sunday, we continue to follow the early stages of the spread of the good news. St Paul — still bearing the name of Saul at this early stage after his miraculous conversion on the road to Damascus — is introduced to the apostles by Barnabas. Quickly he shows his enthusiasm and boldness and we are told that "he started to go round boldly with them in Jerusalem, preaching fearlessly in the name of the Lord."

St John in our Second Reading impresses on his readers the importance of living our faith in God in a real way: "... our love is not to be just words or mere talk, but something real and active..." and that "we live the kind of life that he wants. His commandments are these: that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and that we love one another as he told us to."

In today's Gospel, Our Lord presents us with the beautiful image of the vine. He himself is the true vine and we, as those who belong to him — all the baptised throughout the ages — are the branches. We see this reflected in the lives of the saints, those who have gone before us like Paul, Barnabas and John. We can see a strong image of the Church and how we are never just isolated individuals but, as members together, are all called to bear fruit.

Let us pray that we may bear much fruit, living faithful and active lives of love for the Lord in our world today.
